

Returning members complete the steps. Below are each of the categories.

- 1. Clubs: Select the club(s) that you want to enroll in.
- 2. Projects: Select the project(s). Must be 9 "4-H years" Cloverbuds will select "Exploring 4-H" K-3 grade

***Please note: If you are wanting to go to 4-H Camp and select that for the project it does not enroll you to go to camp. Enrollment for camp takes place at the extension office ***

- 3. Questions: Demographics, Emergency Contact, Parent/Guardian Information, School, ETC.
- 4. Health Form: Health Information
- 5. Consents
- 6. Confirm
